### Mentorship Program

In our mentorship admission system, specific faculty offer admission to students whose research interests are similar to their own. Because of this initial match, students often work with this faculty advisor throughout their graduate careers, though this is not required. Rather, admission under this system carries with it the understanding that the incoming student will conduct his or her master's thesis under the direction of the faculty mentor. However, if after a good-faith effort by both student and mentor, a researchable thesis topic does not develop, the student may change advisors. Additionally, students are encouraged to conduct non-required research with other faculty and may also work with a different faculty member for the dissertation if their research interests change during the years.

On the next page are the faculty members that may be considering new graduate students (N/A indicates the faculty member will not be accepting students for the coming year). Please indicate your preferred mentors in the training area you have selected by ranking them from 1 to 3, with a ranking of 1 for your most preferred mentor. Rank **only** the faculty with whom you are interested in working and only select up to three.
