Graduate Thesis/Dissertation Research Application Instructions

Eligibility:

All Psychological Science graduate students who have complete and obtained approval for their thesis or dissertation research are eligible to apply for these research support funds. Students will be enrolled in at least hour of graduate research (e.g., Psych 8090 or Psych 9090) during the semester(s) in which the research is conducted.

Award Details: The Department will award each successful applicant up to \$400.00. Funds are to be used to cover costs doing research (e.g., animal costs, test purchases, copy and postage costs for surveys, etc.). **Funds used to purchase any reusable item(s) are property of the University of Missouri (e.g., books, computers & accessories, electronics, etc.).** Any questions, please ask.

You may NOT use these funds for salary for anyone and you may NOT use these funds to purchase gifts for assistants.

Graduate research funds are awarded for the current fiscal year (July 1 – June 30). All expenses should be submitted on a Transaction Form to the fiscal office no later than June 1 in order to be reimbursed from these funds.

Application Materials: Two items must be complete:

1. The **application form**: Fill in all of the blanks. You must obtain your advisor's certification and signature. The budget should be filled out as completely as possible.
2. You must also provide **description of the project**. The description can be 1-2 pages long or you can submit a photocopy of your thesis or dissertation proposal (which will be returned to you).

Other Requirements: Awardees are expected to include appropriate acknowledgement in any publication that results from research supported by this grant.
